REPLY TO QUERIES/CLARIFICATIONS BY THE BIDDER

This Supplemental/ Bid Bulletin no. 4 dated February 7, 2022 for the project: **"RE-BIDDING FOR THE UPGRADING OF ELECTRICAL MAINLINE AT BUSTOS CAMPUS (INFRA-2021-23)"**, is issued to modify or amend items in the Bid Document, and to address queries/clarifications sent by bidder through e-mail in compliance with Section 25.5.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184.

1	<p>With your requirement to maintain the form and contents of the documents, following the percentages stated in the Bill of Materials (30% labor cost, 15% OCM, 10% profit, and 5% VAT) would force our estimate to exceed the agency estimate of Php 13,692,765.63, hence resulting in an outright disqualification of our bid.</p> <p>With this, said we would like to request your good office to provide us with the liberty to alter the preset percentages in order to deliver more competitive estimates that would not exceed the agency estimate.</p>	<p>The matter was referred to the Project Management Office (PMO) being the office in-charge of the technical aspect of the project. After careful and thorough review of the concerns and data presented, the PMO and the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) came up with a decision that we cannot give bidders the authority to change the percentage mark-ups specified on the Bill of Materials. These percentage mark-ups are based from the DPWH standard, as per Department Order No. 197 Series of 2016, thus it cannot be adjusted.</p>

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin no. 4 shall form part of the Bidding Documents. All terms, conditions, and instructions to bidders specified in the Bidding Documents inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded and modified accordingly.
