SUBJECT:

System of Ranking of Delivery Units and Individuals

In pursuance to the goal of motivating, rewarding effective and result-oriented public service and in compliance with the conditions of Good Governance set forth by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Harmonization of National Government Performance Monitoring, Information and Reporting Systems (A.O. No. 25, Office of the President of the Philippines, s. 2011) and Memorandum Circular 2020-01 dated June 2, 2020, the following is the system of ranking of delivery units and individuals in connection with the Performance-Based Bonus for Fiscal Year 2020.

1. Qualified Delivery Units of Bulacan State University shall be ranked as follows:

2. The Delivery Units shall be forced ranked on the basic of their general performance established under the Office Performance Commitment Review (OPCR) and shall be appraised on the basis of the following weight system:

The personnel and delivery units other than the colleges will be evaluated on the basis of the Office/Department Performance and Review and the Individual Performance Commitment and Review set forth on the Strategic Performance on Management System of the University. Their performance will be evaluated on the parameters of Quality/Efficiency, Quantity and Timeliness.

- 3. The eligibility of individual shall be governed by the following (Section 6 of MC No. 2020-1)
 - 3.1. The eligibility of the BulSU President shall be based on the requirements set in the CHED Memorandum Order No-4, s. 2015. The FY 2020 eligibility shall also depend on the eligibility and performance of the Bulacan State University and based on the monthly basic salary as of December 31, 2020;
 - 3.2. Employees belonging to the First and Second Levels should receive a rating of at least "Satisfactory" based on our CSC-approved SPMS.3.3 Faculty or Personnel in detail to another government agency for six (6) months or more shall be included in the ranking of employees in the recipient agency that rated his/her performance. Payment of the PBB shall come from the parent agency.
 - 3.3. Faculty or Personnel who transferred from one government agency to another shall be rated and ranked by the agency where h e/she served the longest. If equal months were served for each agency, he/she will be included in the recipient agency.
 - 3.4. Faculty or Personnel who has rendered a minimum of nine (9) months of service during FY 2020 and with a performance rating of at least "Satisfactory " may be eligible for the full grant of the PBB.
 - 3.5. An employee who rendered a minimum of three (3) months but less that nine (9) months of service and with at least "Satisfactory" performance rating shall be eligible for the grant of PBB on a pro-rata basis corresponding to the actual length of service rendered as follows:

Length of Service	% of PBB
8 months but less than 9 months	0.9
7 months but less than 8 months	0.8
6 months but less than 7 months	0.7
5 months but less than 6 months	0.6
4 months but less than 5 months	0.5
3 months but less than 4 months	0.4

The following are the valid reasons for faculty or personnel who may not meet the nine-month actual service requirement to be considered for PBB on a pro-rata basis:

- a. Being a newly hired employee;
- b. Retirement;
- c. Resignation;
- d. Rehabilitation Leave;
- e. Maternity Leave and/or Paternity Leave;

- f. Vacation on or Sick Leave with or without pay;
- g. Scholarship/Study Leave; and
- h. Sabbatical Leave;
- 3.6. A faculty or personnel on vacation leave or sick leave for the entire year, with or without pay, is not eligible for the grant of the PBB.
- 3.7. Faculty or personnel found guilty of administrative and/or criminal cases in FY 2020 by formal executory judgement shall not be entitled to the PBB. If the penalty meted out is only a reprimand, such penalty shall not cause the disqualification to the PBB.
- 3. 8. Officials, faculty, and employee s who failed to submit the 201 9 SALN as prescribed in the rules provided under CSC Memorandum Circular No.3 (s.2015), shall not be entitled to the FY 2020 PBB.
- 3.9. Officials, faculty and employees who failed to liquidate within the reglementary period the Cash Advances received in FY 2019 as required by the COA shall not be entitled to the FY 2020 PBB.
- 3.10. Officials, faculty and employees who failed to submit their SPMS Forms shall not been entitled to the FY 2020 PBB.
